This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that a speaking order has already been passed in the representation dated 13.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the speaking order is reproduced below :-

'It is requested that the investigation regarding the writ petition number CRWP 7621 of 2025 by Lovepreet Kaur and others vs. Punjab Government has been conducted by ASI Gurtej Singh 631/BNL Police Station Mehal Kalan. By whom, the police reached village Maur Nabha Police Station Sehna District Barnala and interrogated the husband of petitioner number 01, Harpreet Singh son of Ajaib Singh resident of Maur Nabha, who wrote his statement that "He had a simple affair about 3 years ago with Lovepreet Kaur daughter of Chamkaur Singh resident of Mehal Khurd, we had a daughter named Mannat. Due to the constant quarrel between us, my wife was not happy with me. I have now come to know that Lovepreet Kaur is living with Gurpreet Singh son of Bhola Singh resident of Mehal Kalan, In the future, we will not interfere in the life of Lovepreet Kaur." The statement is available for reading. Then, the brother-in-law of petitioner number 01, Gurmeet Singh, son of Ajaib Singh, resident of Maur Nabha, wrote in his statement that "My brother had a simple affair with Lovepreet Kaur, daughter of Chamkaur Singh, resident of Mehal Khurd, about 3 years ago, and a girl was born to her, whose name is Mannat. There used to be arguments between them, due to which my sister-in-law was not happy with my brother. I have now come to know that Lovepreet Kaur is living with Gurpreet Singh, son of Bhola Singh, resident of Mehal Kalan. In the future, we will not interfere the life of Lovepreet Kaur." The statement is read with interest.

Then ASI Gurtej Singh 631/BNL reached village Mehal Khurd where ioner Tumber's father Chamkar Singh son of Gurcharan Singh resident of Distt. Barnchal Khurd wrote in his statement that "My daughter Lovepreet Kaur had a simple affair with Harpreet Singh son of Ajaib Singh resident of Maur Nabha about 4 years ago, from whom a girl was born whose name is Mannat. My daughter's son-in-law used to argue with Harpreet Singh, due to which my daughter was not happy with my son-in-law. I have now come to know that Lovepreet Kaur is living with

Gurpreet Singh son of Bhola Singh resident of Mehal Kala. In future, we will not interfere in Lovepreet Kaur's life." The statement is read with interest.

Petitioner No. 01's mother Jaspal Kaur, wife of Chamkaur Singh, son of Gurcharan Singh, resident of Mehal Khurd, wrote in her statement that "My daughter Lovepreet Kaur was married to Harpreet Singh, son of Ajaib Singh, resident of Maur Nabha, about 4 years ago, from whom a girl was born whose name is Mannat. My daughter used to have arguments with her son-in-law Harpreet Singh, due to which my daughter was not happy with my son-in-law. I have now come to know that Lovepreet Kaur is living with Gurpreet Singh, son of Bhola Singh, resident of Mehal Kalan. In the future, we will not interfere in the life of Lovepreet Kaur." The statement.'

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch)., in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
