Status report by way of an affidavit of Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, NRI Wing, District Amritsar has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, in compliance of order dated 17.07.2025, which is taken on record.

It has been alleged in the status report that the concerned police officials of Police Station NRI Wing, Amritsar investigated into the complaint of respondent No.4. The counselling of the petitioner and respondent No.4 was held by officials of Police Station NRI Wing, Amritsar, during which respondent No.4 made statement that she had compromised the matter with the petitioner and the petitioner agreed to return Rs.1,85,000/- to respondent No.4 by 15.07.2025 and she did not wish to proceed with her complaint. Thereafter, respondent No.3 submitted the enquiry report on 14.06.2025. Copy of said report Annexure B and copy of

compromise Annexure C have also been annexed with the status report. It has been alleged in the status report that the petitioner has filed the present petition on false and frivolous allegations against respondents No.1 to 3, merely to escape her liability to refund the amount of Rs.1,85,000/- to respondent No.4 and the present petition is devoid of any merit.

Keeping in view of the aforesaid status report, no further order is required to be passed and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
