The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer of issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 and 3 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and her children especially at the hands of the respondent No.4 who is taking illegal possession of the properties belongs to late husband of the petitioner and selling them further like the respondents No.5 to 11, in illegal and unlawful manner, despite the fact that the learned Civil Court has already passed an interim order in favour of the petitioner and her children, but despite repeated requests to the learned Court as well as to the high police authorities, the respondent No.4 is selling the said lands further to the other persons like the respondents No.5 to 11.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 30.06.2025 (Annexure P-2), within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Director General of Police, Punjab, to look into the representation dated 30.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks by passing a speaking order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
