The petitioner has challenged the order dated 05.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) whereby he had been re-located to another vending site.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was earlier working as a street vendor in Sector 19, Chandigarh and arbitrarily, he had been asked to shift to another vending site. He also submits that he was not issued any notice prior to re-location of the vending site.

3. Mr. Sanjeev Ghai, Advocate, who appeared on advance notice on behalf of the respondent/UT, Chandigarh, submits that a perusal of the provisional Certificate of Vending (Annexure P-4) clearly reveals that the petitioner had been allotted vending site in Sector 49 way back on 05.12.2019.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered view that this petition has been filed 06 years after the petitioner

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was allotted the vending site at Sector 49, vide the provisional Certificate of Vending (Annexure P-4). There is no explanation whatsoever for the huge delay in preferring the writ petition.

5. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
