1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 29.03.2023, under Sections 323, 341, 506 & 34 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Commissionerate Ludhiana Dehlon, District Ludhiana. Further prayer has been made for staying the arrest of the petitioner, during the pendency of present petition.
2. Vide order dated 22.07.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 22.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has further submitted that the quashing petition bearing CRM-M No.35069 of 2025 filed on the basis of compromise, has already been quashed and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.

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4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation. He endorsed the fact that the quashing petition stands quashed.

6. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
