1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.148 dated 19.03.2025, registered under Section 25 of Immigration Act and Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliations Centre and settlement remained successful. He further submits that through the petitioner was to pay Rs.5 Lakhs today but due to financial constraints in the family, he could pay only Rs.3 Lakhs and submits that rest of the amount would also be cleared as per terms and conditions. As per terms and conditions, the full and final payment is to be cleared by 30.12.2025. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.



3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 06.08.2025 and he is no more required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above, interim order dated 06.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S. However, the petitioner would be bound by terms and condition of compromise arrived at between both the parties. Parties would be at liberty to invoke their remedies in case, non-compliance of the terms and conditions of the agreement arrived at between them.
5. Petition stands allowed.
6. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
