1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance
of a direction to the respondents to regularize his services in view of the
provisions contained in the Punjab Ad-hoc, Contractual, Daily wage,
Temporary Work charged and Outsource Employees Welfare Act, 2016
(hereinafter referred to as '2016 Act').



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2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in spite of the fact that the petitioner is eligible for regularization of his services in terms of the 2016 Act, the respondents are not considering the case of petitioner for regularization.

3 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-State submits that the case of petitioner has not been considered for regularization of his services in terms of various schemes and circulars issued by the Government from time to time as the petitioner has not submitted any application in this regard.

4. Taking into consideration the facts of this case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to treat the present writ petition as a representation and decide the case of the petitioner for regularization in terms of 2016 Act, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
