1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the order of penalty dated 28.07.2024 (Annexure P/11) passed by the respondents, an appeal dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P/12) has been preferred by the petitioner, which is not being decided by the authorities concerned though, the order of penalty is being implemented qua the petitioner as 10% cut in pension for 05 years has been imposed, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner hence, the respondents be directed to decide the said appeal dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P/12) preferred by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

3. Mr. Rahul Rampal, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, appeal dated 15.01.2025 (Annexure P/12) against the order of penalty, has been filed by the

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petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authority concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which speaking order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present application may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
