1. The applicant-petitioner has filed the instant application under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to release the applicant-petitioner on interim bail on medical grounds.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that the applicant-petitioner had met with an accident in the year 2021 and had suffered a fracture on his shoulder. The petitioner had to undergo a surgery and medical plates and screws were fixed on his shoulder. The applicant/petitioner remained admitted in PGIMER, Chandigarh for treatment on different occasions. Learned counsel further submits that the applicant-petitioner is again facing health issues and is having pain in his shoulder and spine. However, the petitioner is not being provided proper medical treatment by the jail authorities.



3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the applicant/petitioner has been taken to Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur for consultation with an Orthopaedist and proper medical treatment is being provided to him. He has been advised to medication and the treatment is being provided to him, as required. Even his vitals are stated to be stable.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. At this stage, keeping in view the medical condition of the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to release the applicant/petitioner on interim bail on medical grounds.

6. Dismissed.

7. However, the Superintendent, Central Jail, Hoshiarpur is directed to provide the proper medical treatment to the applicant/petitioner as per advice of the doctors. If found necessary by the treating doctors, the petitioner shall be taken to a Multi-Speciality Government Hospital for his proper treatment and management.

8. Application stands dismissed.

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1. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition.
