1. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of impugned enquiry report dated 05.04.2021 (Annexure P-3), impugned orders dated 22.04.2025 and 24.06.2025, Annexures P-5 and P-6, respectively, whereby the petitioner has been placed under suspension and further has been charge sheeted in violation of the statutory service rules. It has been further prayed that respondent(s)-authorities be directed to reinstate the petitioner alongwith all consequential benefits from the date he has been placed under suspension, alongwith interest.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner shall be satisfied at this stage, if competent authority/the Board of Directors of respondent No.2 be directed to decide the matter afresh by taking into consideration all the pleas as raised by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 30.05.2025 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Puru Jarewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1, 5 and 8 and Mr. Ashwani Prashar, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 4. They do not oppose the limited prayer made by the petitioner.

5. In view thereof, without commenting anything on the merits of the claim raised by the petitioner, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the competent authority/Board of Directors of respondent No. 2 to decide the legal notice dated 30.05.2025 (Annexure P-7) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to state that the competent authority/Board of Directors of respondent No. 2 shall provide due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and will pass a reasoned and speaking order while deciding the aforesaid legal notice dated 30.05.2025 (Annexure P-7).

7. Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
