1. Instant writ petition has been filed, inter alia, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 23.06.2025, Annexure P4, passed by respondents No.3 to 5, whereby departmental proceedings against private respondents No.6 and 7 have been stayed.

2. On 18.07.2025, without issuing notice to the respondents, this Court had called upon respondent No.6 to apprise this Court regarding the status of the departmental proceedings initiated against private respondents. On the deferred date, respondent No.5 appeared in person and apprised the Court that preliminary inquiry was being conducted on the complaint submitted by the petitioner. She informed



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the Court that the petitioner as well as her counsel are trying to influence the proceedings and had even threatened the committee members. She extended an assurance that preliminary inquiry will be concluded as expeditiously as possible.

3. During the course of hearing today, upon instructions from respondent No.5, State counsel submits that preliminary inquiry has been concluded on 10.10.2025. He has categorical instructions to state that allegations levelled against private respondents have not been established and a report has been submitted to the Civil Surgeon, Panchkula.

4. In view of the above development, prayer made in the writ petition has become infructuous.

5. Writ petition as well as the miscellaneous application are disposed of.
