1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of mandamus upon the respondents concerned to release the retiral dues including Gratuity, Leave Encashment, GPF, Arrears, ACP Arrears and other retiral benefits.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide his legal notice dated 20.6.2025 (Annexure P-2), in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Puru Jarewal, DAG, Punjab appearing for the respondents does not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide legal notice dated 20.6.2025 (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
