1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to release his retiral benefits.

2. The petitioner joined Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh in August' 2010. On account of absence from duty, he was subjected to minor punishment. He filed resignation which was duly accepted by the respondent. He claims that he is entitled to service benefits for the period he has served respondent. He has served multiple notices upon the respondent but to no avail.

3. Mr. Avinit Avasthi, Additional Standing Counsel, U.T., Chandigarh, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, assures the Court that competent authority would consider
