AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common judgment.
2. Prayer made in the present petitions for directing the respondents to implement the order dated 08.05.2025 as also to revise the pensioner/retiral benefits.
3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners are employees of Punjab Roadways and seeking the relief based on judgment referred in the case of **Daljit Singh and others vs. State of Punjab**, CWP-9175-2000, decided on 26.05.2017 (Annexure P4) against which LPA filed by the State of Punjab bearing No. 659 of 2018 was also dismissed on 27.02.2019 as also SLP No.14572 of 2019 on

17.01.2025. He on instructions states that the claim of the petitioners may be considered in light of the aforesaid judgment, in a time bound manner.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, these petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioners, within a period of 4 months, taking note of the aforesaid judgment, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
