1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.PC for issuance of direction to official respondents to complete the investigation and file the status report in case FIR No.180 dated 19.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420/120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Division E, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Status report dated 17.11.2024 has already been filed by the State by way of affidavit of Mr. Gagandeep Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Economic Offences Wing, Amritsar, which is taken on record.

3. At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the investigating agency has already concluded the investigation and is likely to present the final report under Section 173 Cr.PC before the jurisdictional Court within a short while. He further submits that one of the accused, who has been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, is yet to join the investigation. Therefore, the
