Challenge in the present writ petition is to the rejection order dated 17.06.2025 and further to direct the respondents to grant compassionate transfer to the petitioner to a unit near Delhi in view of the verified medical condition of his wife.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the condition of the petitioner's wife is very critical and she needs regular treatment for the same and all kinds of medical facilities are easily available in Delhi. He further submits that in order to get proper medical treatment for his wife, it is essential for him to be posted in Delhi. The

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petitioner is now posted in Pinjore and facing hardships to get proper treatment for his wife. He had filed CWP-15249 of 2025 titled as “*Satyaveer versus Union of India and others*” which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 26.05.2025 with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 24.04.2025. Pursuant to the said order, the respondents passed the impugned order dated 17.06.2025 while dismissing the representation dated 24.04.2025. He submits that the said order has been passed arbitrarily in a mechanical manner and the same is against the principles of natural justice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rakesh Verma, Senior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

However, in view of the order which this Court intends to pass, the reply of the respondents would not be necessary at this stage.

After taking into consideration the medical condition of the petitioner’s wife which is duly supported by verified medical record and in view of the averments made in the present writ petition, it would be appropriate to direct the respondent No.2-the Director General, CRPF, CGO Complex, New Delhi is directed to take a fresh decision on the representation dated 24.04.2025.

Resultantly, the instant writ petition is disposed of at this stage and the impugned order dated 17.06.2025 passed by respondent No.2 is hereby set aside. The matter is remanded to the competent authority of



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respondents to take a fresh decision on the representation dated 24.04.2025 within a period of three months. Petitioner is directed to appear before the competent authority of the respondents and submit all relevant record. The competent authority shall be at liberty to seek report with respect to the medical condition of the wife of the petitioner from the base Hospital.
