1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 12.05.2025, registered under Sections 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 21.07.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



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5. In view of the above, interim order dated 21.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

6. Petition stands allowed.
