Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 12.07.2025 (Annexure P1) before respondents No.2 to 4, but no action on the same has been taken till date. He submits that he would be satisfied if respondents No.3 is directed to look into and decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 12.07.2025 (Annexure P-1) is looked into.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the aforesaid representation and to take appropriate action as per law, if any required, at the earliest.
