1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Learned State counsel appears on advance notice and on instructions from ASI Davinder Kumar, informs the Court that the jurisdictional police authorities have recorded statements of the private respondents No.4 to 7, in which it has been categorically stated that they have

no objection with regard to relationship of the petitioner with the boy namely Lovepreet Singh. They have also undertaken not to interfere in the life of the petitioner in any manner. As such, no ground is made out for issuance of any directions, as prayed for.

3. In view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of.
