KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ, seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 13.06.2024 (Annexure P-3), vide which the learned Permanent Lok Adalat concerned, has declined the claim of interim relief for release of temporary electricity connection to the petitioner.

2. This Court, vide order dated 21.04.2025, during the course of the hearing, had directed the learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3, to have apt instructions from the quarter concerned, as to what are the legal impediments in supplying the temporary electricity connection to the petitioner specifically, when the distribution licensee has issued the notification on dated 25.10.2024.

3. Today, learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 3, after having instructions from the quarter concerned, informs this Court, that the respondent-distribution licensee is ready to consider the case of the petitioner



for grant of temporary electricity connection, in case, the petitioner approach the distribution licensee concerned, and complete all the requisite formalities thereof.

4. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned counsel for the respondents No.2 and 3, this Court is of the considered opinion that the instant writ petition can be disposed of, while granting liberty to the petitioner, to approach the respondents No.2 and 3, for redressal of his grievance. In case, the petitioner fulfills all the requisite formalities, the latter shall consider the case of the petitioner for grant of temporary electricity connection, specifically, considering the notification dated 25.10.2024.

5. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of**.
