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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents authorities to consider the case of the petitioner for allotment of Fair Price Shop (Ration Depot) subject to regular allotment of fair price shops after completing due process of law in the interest of justice.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case the process has already not been initiated, the concerned authority shall initiate the process for the allotment of Fair Price Shop (Ration Depot) within eight weeks from today, wherein the petitioner may also apply,.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in this writ petition.

4. The instant writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

5. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
