1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92 dated 18.06.2025, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 190, 191(2), 191(3), 324(4), 333, 351(2) BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station West, Sector 11, Chandigarh.
2. Today, on instructions from HC Parveen Kumar, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 21.07.2025 and is no longer required for further investigation.
