AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer made is for directing the respondents to regularize the service of the petitioner on the post of Mali.
2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is entitled for consideration in terms of the policy dated 18.03.2011, as also the Punjab Ad hoc, Contractual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Outsourced Employees' Welfare Act, 2016, with regard to which a representation (Annexure P-24) has been submitted, but the same has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.
3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to

the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-24), within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to his and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
