1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release and disburse the retiral benefits to the petitioner, i.e., leave encashment, welfare fund admissible after retirement on 31.01.2020 to the petitioner along with 12% interest per annum from the date of retirement till realization.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the main petition with liberty to file it afresh with the better particulars.

3. In view of the same, present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.
