1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner has applied for the grant of stage carriage route permit on the route BOHA to MODA on 18.06.2020 (Annexure P-2) but the said application is not being decided, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 10.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State submits that in case, the legal notice dated 10.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) has been received from the petitioner in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for grant of any relief, the same will be granted to him, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order the said reasons will also be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
6. Ordered accordingly.
