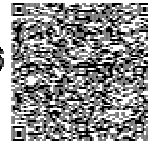

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to release the detenue namely Salma, who is his wife, from Safe House/Nari Niketan.

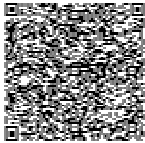
2. A perusal of the record reveals that the petitioner has filed a petition bearing number CRWP-5691-2025 with identical prayer, which was disposed of on 28.05.2025 by this Court. The said order reads as under:

“Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing respondent Nos. 2 to 4 for releasing detenue, namely, (S) wife of petitioner from safe house/Nari Niketan.

2. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel for petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition with liberty to take recourse to any other remedy in accordance with law.

3. Disposed off with liberty aforesaid.
