1. Present petition has been filed for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.253 dated 13.06.2025 for offence under Section 21(c) of NDPS Act (under Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot for a period of two months to the treatment of his father namely Daljeet Singh, who is in serious condition.

2. In compliance to the order dated 23.07.2025, status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Tarlochan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Faridkot, District Faridkot has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, in the Court today, same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report filed and submits that in the verification report, it has been found that contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner regarding the serious condition of his father has not been

substantiated and though his father went to the doctor for treatment, however, after taking treatment, he never returned back and he thus, submits that no ground for grant of interim bail to the petitioner, is made out.

4 In view of the above and keeping in view the status report, this Court does not find any ground for grant of interim bail to the petitioner. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
