1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 226 dated 12.07.2025 under Sections 21(B)/61/85 of NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, Sirsa.

2. The case of the prosecution is that 6.58 grams of Heroin from the co-accused Anil Kumar was recovered and on his disclosure statement he disclosed that he purchased the contraband from the present petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case only on the basis of disclosure statement made by the co-accused. No recovery has been effected from the him.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He has opposed the prayer for concession of bail to the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is involved in another case under NDPS Act i.e. FIR No 132 of 2022.



6. I have heard the submissions made by the parties and gone through the record.

7. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is involved in another case under the NDPS Act, which shows that the petitioner is a habitual offender and has criminal antecedents, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
