The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to grant the promotion on the post of Sub Inspector/Yard Master by counting the past service of the petitioners and release all the consequential benefits to the petitioner and a further prayer to direct the respondents to decide the representation/application dated 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-1).

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted his representation/application dated 03.06.2025



(Annexure P-1) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-the Director General, State Transport Department, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the representation/application dated 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation/application dated 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-1) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of **four** months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
