3. On the asking of the Court, Dr. Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana accpets notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 and waive service. They do not oppose the prayer, as made by the learned cousnel for the petitioners.
