The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 11.03.2025 registered under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 and later on added Section 29 of the NDPS Act registered at P.S. Ladhuwal, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.07.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed affidavit dated 18.08.2025 of Mr. Jatinder Pal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, West, Ludhiana in the court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 22.07.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



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In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.07.2025 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
