This is an application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 125 days in filing the appeal.

Keeping in view the facts mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 125 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellants submits that he has instructions to say that the appellants intend to make an application for the allotment of the land under a policy issued by the Government of Haryana and the said application, be decided in a time bound

Learned counsel for respondent-State submits that in case any such representation is made by the appellants, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of three months of the receipt of the same and in case, it is found feasible to accept the request of the appellants, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim, which reasons will be conveyed to the appellants.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having not been pressed any further with liberty to file a representation.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
