The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.219 dated 10.07.2025 registered under Sections 109(1), 111(3), 121(1), 132, 221, 223(a), 324(4), 303(2) BNS and 4(i) Mines and Minerals Act registered at P.S. Chandhuth, District Palwal.

The Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Amit at the very outset submits that since there is no evidence against the petitioner, therefore, he is not an accused and is not sought to be arrested.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of being premature.

However, in case at a subsequent stage he is sought to be made



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an accused at the instance of the investigating agency he is at liberty to approach the Sessions Court for grant of anticipatory bail.
