The petitioner has sought quashing of impugned demand of Rs.12,06,250/- raised vide condition No.3 of allotment letter.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have erroneously raised a demand of Rs.12,06,250/- without any justifiable basis. The petitioner has sent a representation in this regard on 06.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) to the Chief Administrator, but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that the petition may be disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

3. Issue notice to the respondents.

4. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Arundhati Kulshreshtha, Assistant Advocate General, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.1-State. Mr. H.P.S. Sandhu, Advocate with Mr. Avin Kumar Sandhu, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

5. Heard.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 06.05.2025 (Annexure P-2) preferred by the petitioner in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
