1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 20.03.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the court of Rent Controller, Fatehgarh Sahib, as per which the application dated 12.12.2022 for dismissing the petition, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in spite of his best efforts, he has not been able to get in touch with the petitioner and even no one has approached his office so as to state as to whether any cause survives in the present petition or not. It is prayed that the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause survives.
