SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of orders dated 21.10.2024 and 25.04.2024, passed by this Court.

2. The relevant para 4 of the order dated 21.10.2024 passed by this Court, is reproduced as under:-

*“4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without even filing a representation, the petitioner has filed the present petition seeking a writ of mandamus, which remedy is not available to him and in case, any representation is received from the petitioner raising any grievance based upon the judgment in **Dharam Singh’s case (supra)**, the same will be considered and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.”*

3. In compliance of order dated 21.10.2024, the respondents passed the speaking order dated 21.01.2025, which is attached with the present petition as Annexure P-6.



4. In view of the above, the present civil original contempt petition is not maintainable and hence, dismissed.
