SANJAY VASHISTH. J.(Oral)

1. Present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for quashing of FIR No.123 dated 03.11.2024, under Sections 108 and 3(5), of BNS, 2023 (Sections 306 and 34 of IPC), registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the compromise has been effected between the parties and quashing has been sought on that ground, yet there are ample reasons for quashing of the FIR, as no offence is made out under Section 306 IPC (108 of BNS), even if the allegations are admitted.
3. Thus, he submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh along with the factum of compromise which has already been arrived at between the parties.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as sought and recorded here-above.
