1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, upon the respondents, to issue registration certificate in favour of the petitioner as 'Pharmacist', in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2-Haryana State Pharmacy Council, has caused appearance, and has filed the written statement on behalf of the respondent No.2, today in the Court. The same is taken on the record.

3. The written statement (supra), speaks about the final decision taken by the authorities concerned, by drawing a speaking order dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure R-2/6), wherein, the application preferred by the petitioner, has been dismissed.

4. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant petition, and the same is hereby, **closed**.
5. However, in case, the petitioner fetches any grievance from the speaking order (supra), he is at liberty to challenge the same before the apt forum concerned, by filing apt motion.
