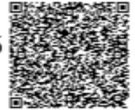

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

In pursuance to the advance notice, Mr. Jastej Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice and submitted that a speaking order has already been passed in the representation dated 18.07.2025 (Annexure P-5) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the speaking order is reproduced below :-

“This speaking order is being issued in reference to CRWP No. 7861 of 2025, titled "kajal Kaur and another vs. State of Punjab and others" which is presently



pending before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court.

In compliance with the said matter, a preliminary enquiry was conducted by the Incharge, Police Station Ghuman kalan, gurdaspur

During the course of enquiry, the statements of the petitioners-Ms. kajal Kaur, daughter of Sh. Labh Singh resident of bharowal tehsil khadoor sahib distt Tarantarn, Now Wife Mr Rajpreet singh, son of Sh. Gurdev Singh residents of Village Ghuman kalan and Mr. Rajpreet singh, son of Sh. Gurdev Singh residents of Village Ghuman kalan, District Gurdaspur were duly recorded. The petitioners submitted that they had solemnized their marriage with each other on 18.7.25 of their own free will and are presently residing together peacefully. They did not express any apprehension of threat to their life or liberty during the recording of their statements. The petitioners further stated that in the event of any future concern or incident, they shall approach the police authorities for appropriate assistance.

It is further submitted that in the aforementioned writ petition, the petitioners had expressed apprehension of threat to their life and liberty from the following individuals:

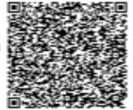
1, Jatinder Kumar S/o Bhagat Ram R/o B.S. Colony Near Shani Mandir, Rayya, Distt Amritsar

2.Sandeep Kaur W/o Jatinder Kumar R/o B.S. Colony Near Shani Mandir, Rayya, Distt Amritsar

3. Mintu Singh S/o Shindha R/o Vallah Verka The & Distt Amritsar

4. Kirandeep Kaur Wife of Mintu Singh R/o Vallah Verka The & Distt Amritsar

As part of the enquiry, the above-named individuals Jatinder Kumar & Sandeep Kaur were contacted telephonically (99153-55521 kajal Kaur Brother In Law & Sister of Petitioner No. 1) by the ASI Kulwinder Singh 1298/Gsp Police Station Ghuman Kalan. They affirmed that



the marriage of the petitioners had taken place with mutual consent and conveyed that they have no objection to the said marriage. They further assured that there is no interference or hostility from their side, and that the petitioners are under no threat from them.

It is also pertinent to mention that no complaint has been received at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, in relation to the present matter

In view of the above, no threat perception has been established at this stage. Therefore, no further action is deemed necessary at present.”

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioners does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
