1. The violation of the order dated 15.03.2023 passed in CWP No.5135 of 2023 has been alleged wherein, following directions have been issued:-

*“Resultantly, the writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 09.01.2023 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled, his claim be released within a period of **four weeks** thereafter along with interest (if any) granted to the similarly situated persons.*

In case, the respondents feel that petitioner is not entitled for the same he shall pass a speaking order. Any further delay shall entail interest @ of 18% per annum and the same shall be recoverable from the personal pocket of respondent No.3.”

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh has been filed by the respondent-State. The same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in compliance of the aforesaid directions, a speaking order dated 31.01.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the Assistant Inspector General, GRP, Punjab, Patiala.

4. In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly with the liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy available to him in accordance with the law.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
