Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners endangered at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 8 for which representation dated 04.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) has already been submitted to respondent No.2, but despite that no action has been taken thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.3 has already filed a civil suit regarding the land in dispute and learned Civil Court has granted injunction which was not further challenged by the private respondent-defendants, but despite that the petitioners are being threatened to be dispossessed. He further submits that for the redressal of the grievances of the petitioners, a representation dated 04.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) has already been filed before respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.



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After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to decide the representation dated 04.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of one month from today and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, is perceived. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners for legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
