The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent no.4.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 23.07.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“The CRWP no. 7921 of 2025 was filed before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court at Chandigarh in which petitioners seeks Protection of life and liberty On receiving the copy of which petition Nisha aged about 23 daughter of Satpal resident of Village Jiven Basti Kaleke District Barnala now wife of Amandeep Singh resident of Village Saggu Patti Kaleke District Barnala Adhaar Card no 789400931629 Ph No. 8289020130 were contacted but mobile

number 82890-20130, given in petition was found to be switched off. Police Party further tried to reach private respondents but they were not present at given address. HC RANJEET SINGH 950/BL is deputed to trace out private respondents It is also checked from record that any complaint regarding the protection of life and liberty of petitioners is not carlier received in thc police station. However, as and when petitioners are located or they themselves appear before this police station appropriate action shall be taken accordingly as per law. This speaking order is passed accordingly.”

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
