1. The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of directions to the respondents to promote him to the post of Works Manager in the Transport Department, Haryana in view of the order dated 06.08.2012.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner(s) has already submitted a representation dated 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) to the respondent(s) but no action has been taken thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner(s) would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-The Director General, State Transport, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the said representation, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s)-State and prays for some time to complete



instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2-The Director General, State Transport, Haryana to consider and decide the representation dated 03.06.2025 (Annexure P-2) and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
