SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J.(Oral)

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that a speaking order has already been passed in the representation dated 18.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the speaking order is reproduced below :-

‘Whereas Sandeep Singh aged 20 years s/o Rajinder singh R/o Village Sohangerh Rattewala Police station Guruharsahai and Sarabjit Kaur aged 18 years d/o Jassa singh r/o Rorran wali District Shri Muktsar sahib, now living in relation with Sandeep Singh s/o Rajinder singh R/o Village Sohangerh Rattewala Police station Guruharsahai, had moved a complaint before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur alleging threat perception from the family members of Sarabjit Kaur. The complainants have mentioned in their complaint that they both are majors and they both are living happily in relation against the wishes of parents of girl namely Sarabjit Kaur and now they are apprehending danger to their lives at the hands of family members of girls i.e. Jassa singh s/o gurdita singh, sukhpal kaur w/o jassa singh, Tarsem singh s/o Gurdita singh, Hardeep kaur w/o Tarsem singh, satnam singh s/o Madan singh, Sukhchain singh s/o madan singh, Prem singh s/o madan singh, madan singh s/o channa singh, Kirtan singh s/o gurpartap singh, Jiwan singh s/o Gurpartap singh, Gurpartap singh s/o channa singh, Param singh s/o jassa singh all resident of Village rorran wali district shri Muktsar sahib and have demanded protection of their life and liberty. During enquiry, undersigned i.e. SHO, PS: Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, along with his team visited village Sohangerh Rattewala i.e. present address where both of them are residing and both the complainants were not found present at the given address in the complaint and no other family member were present at home. However the undersigned approached sarpanch Gurbaj singh and said Gurbaj Singh to inform immediately to the Police of PS: Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur as and when the complainants or their family member came back to the aforesaid address given in the complaint or if they would found any contact number of complainants. However in future, if the complainants approached the Police Department with the request to obtain any kind of protection through any written complaint or representation, then the same will be

provided to them immediately, without any kind of delay. Further the patrolling party of the area of complainants, also directed by the undersigned to keep vigilant in view of the seriousness of the matter. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, at this stage no protection can be provided to the complainants as they were not found Present at the given address in the complaint..’

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
