1. This Writ Petition is directed against a communication dated 19.06.2025, whereby a fresh Committee has been constituted for fresh inspection, for grant of affiliation in favour of the petitioner to run Dual System Course (DST') for the trades of Electrician and Wiremen.

2. The basis of challenge to the impugned communication is the fact that a previous inspection for such purposes was carried out and according to the petitioner, the report dated 09.12.2024 found all parameters to have been met by the petitioner for grant of requisite permission. It is, therefore, submitted that the direction to undertake the inspection process again is without any basis.

3. Counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the State, wherein it is pointed out that though the report was submitted on 09.12.2024, but when the State authorities proceeded further in the matter, it was found that various columns of the prescribed form, requiring different informations,
