1. Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to issue the police clearance certificate to the petitioner which is under consideration since April 2024.

2. State counsel submits that an FIR bearing No.96 dated 06.05.2022 offences under Sections 323, 326, 427 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'IPC') was registered against the petitioner at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga but a cancellation report has been submitted. Upon instructions from SHO Bhalwinder Singh, Dharmkot, he states that the police clearance certificate will be issued to the petitioner within a fortnight from today, in case petitioner is not found to be involved in any other criminal case.
