The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 BNSS is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.36 dated 08.04.2018 under Sections 324/148/149 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and therefore, as the petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2025, he be granted the concession of bail.

3. The factum of compromise has not been denied by the learned counsel for the complainant who submits that he has no objection if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail.

4. The learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, contends that he is unaware of the compromise which has purportedly been arrived at.



5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the contentions raised by the learned counsel for petitioner and the acceptance on the part of the counsel for the complainant, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner incarcerated.
7. Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Raman is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
8. The present petition stands disposed of.
