This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

In pursuance to the advance notice Mr. J.S. Rattu, DAG, Punjab appears and submits that a speaking order dated 22.07.2025 has already been passed in the representation dated 18.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. Learned State counsel informs the Court that the same is not up to the mark and it has been returned back to the SSP for consideration of the representation and passing of a fresh speaking order and he assures the Court that necessary action will be taken on the representation dated 18.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) after providing an



opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, by passing a fresh speaking order within a period of three days from today, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further.

The present petition stands dismissed as not pressed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.
