This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 23.08.2011 passed by this Court in CWP-19214-2009.
