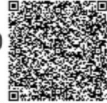
SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J.(ORAL)

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents not to harass the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

In pursuance to the advance notice, Mr. J.S. Rattu, DAG, Punjab appears and submits that a speaking order has already been passed in the representation dated 16.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) by the authorities concerned and has produced the copy of the same, which is taken on record. He has furnished a copy of the order to counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the speaking order is reproduced below :-

“It is humbly submitted that an application bearing No. 364-Local, dated 20-07-2025, has been received at



Police Station City Fazilka from the petitioners, Ms. Sumitra, daughter of Sita Ram, and Mr. Amandeep Singh, son of Sukhdev Singh, residents of Radha Soami Colony, Street No. 04, Fazilka.

In this regard, Ms. Sumitra was contacted on the mobile number 78146-15826, which was provided by her in the application. However, despite the communication, neither Ms. Sumitra nor Mr. Amandeep Singh has not appeared in person at local police station for protection.

As and when the approach to local police then protection will be provided to them. as per their statements.”

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition further.

The petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch)., in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.

Petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
